



## ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE – ARC

Further, the Committee works in coordination with faculty members, hostel wardens, security personnel, administrative officials, and student representatives to ensure effective surveillance, early detection, and immediate response to any incidents or complaints related to ragging. It also conducts regular awareness programmes, counseling sessions, and monitoring activities to promote healthy peer relationships and a positive campus culture.

The Anti-Ragging Committee maintains proper records and documentation of complaints received, actions taken, awareness programmes conducted, inspections carried out, and compliance reports submitted. It ensures transparency, accountability, and strict adherence to institutional and statutory guidelines for maintaining discipline and safety within the campus.

Based on periodic reviews and reports, the Anti-Ragging Committee submits detailed findings, recommendations, and compliance reports to the Management and Governing Council of A.K.T. Memorial College of Engineering and Technology for ensuring continuous improvement in safety measures, student discipline, and the creation of a ragging-free campus environment.
