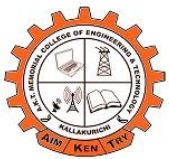

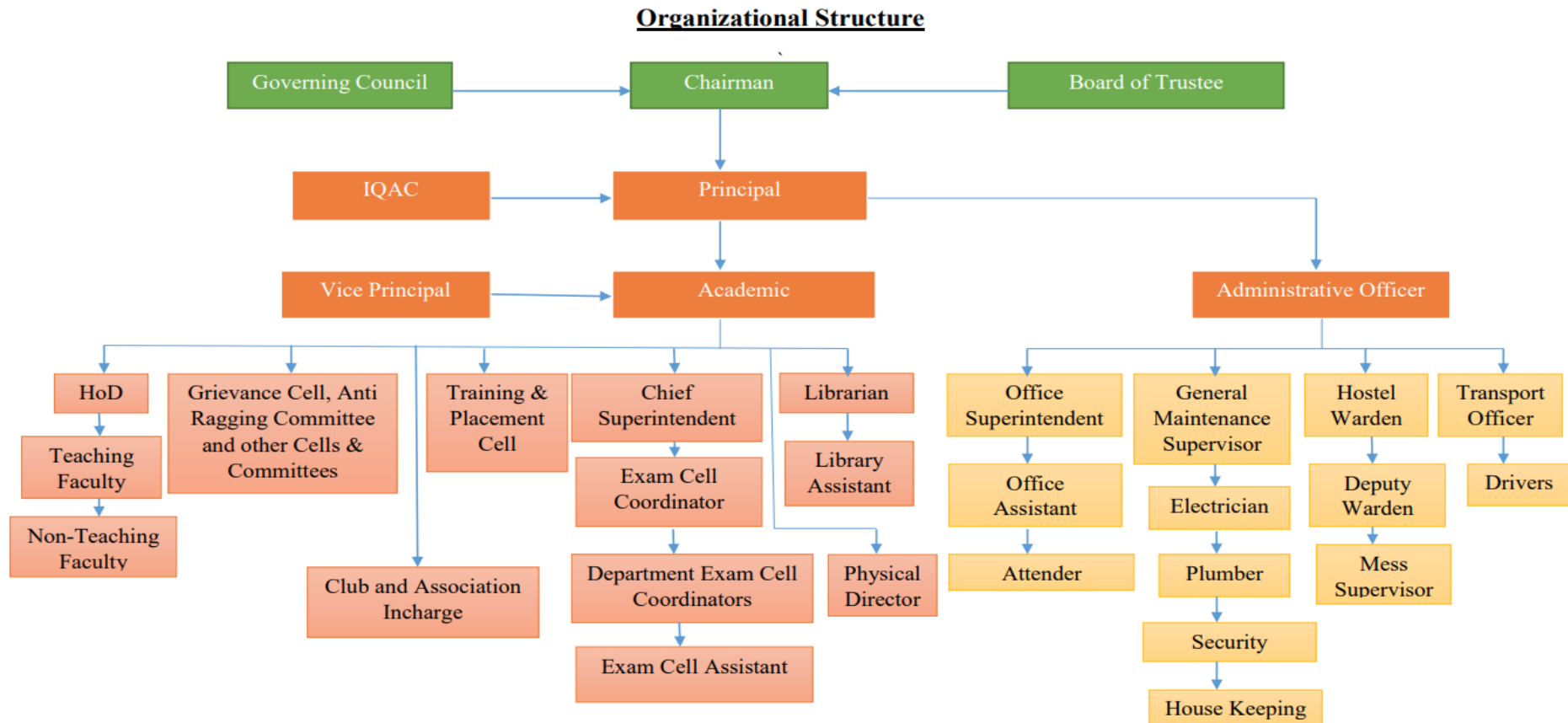

## 5.2 ONLINE/OFFLINE GRIEVANCE AND REDRESSAL MECHANISM

A.K.T. Memorial College of Engineering and Technology has instituted a robust, transparent, and student-centric Online and Offline Grievance and Redressal Mechanism to address the grievances of students, faculty members, and non-teaching staff in a fair, impartial, and time-bound manner, in accordance with AICTE, UGC, and other statutory norms. The mechanism aims to create a harmonious academic environment by ensuring that genuine concerns are addressed effectively and without fear of prejudice or retaliation.

A formally constituted Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC), comprising senior faculty members and administrative representatives, is responsible for receiving, examining, and evaluating the validity of grievances related to academic matters, examinations, administration, infrastructure, hostel facilities, transport, finance, discipline, or any other institutional issues. The Committee functions independently and adheres strictly to the principles of natural justice.

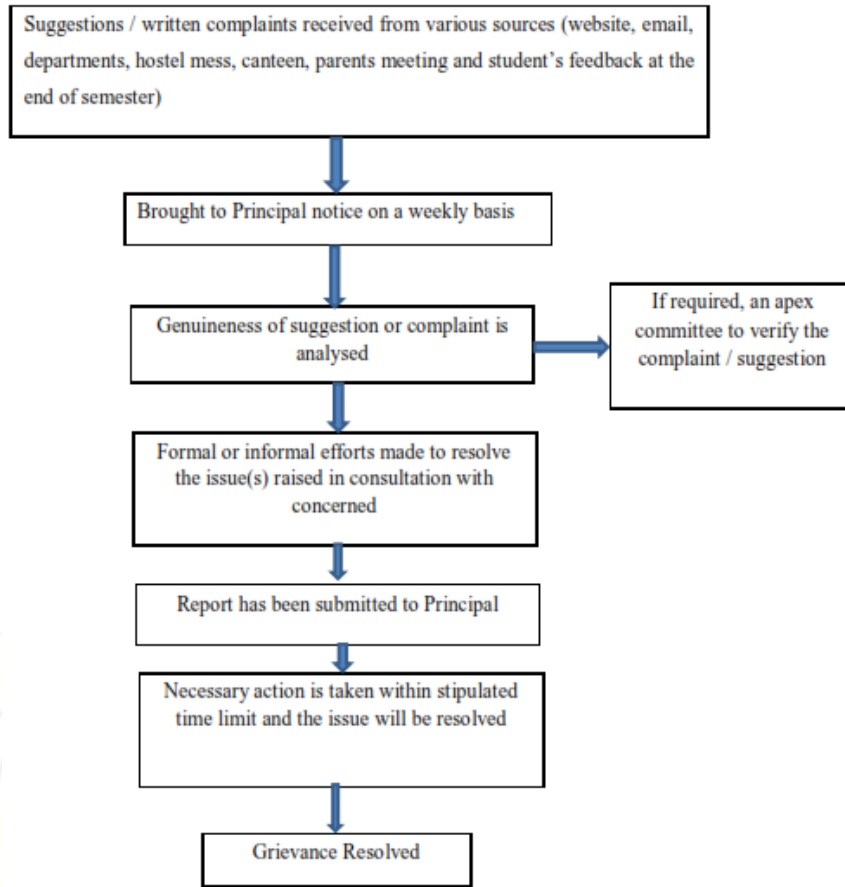
As a first level of redressal, students with genuine grievances are encouraged to approach the counsellor, concerned course teacher, faculty advisor, or the Head of the Department (HOD) in person. This informal mechanism enables early identification of issues and facilitates speedy and amicable resolution at the departmental level.

If the grievance is not resolved at this stage or if the complainant is unable or unwilling to present the issue in person, the Institution provides multiple channels for grievance submission. Offline grievances may be submitted in writing by dropping the complaint in the complaint/suggestion boxes installed at prominent locations on all floors of the academic blocks and in the respective hostels. Online grievances can be submitted by sending a detailed representation to the official email ID of the College or through the institutional grievance portal, wherever available.

All grievances received through online or offline modes are systematically recorded and acknowledged. The Grievance Redressal Committee reviews each complaint, conducts enquiries or personal hearings wherever necessary, and recommends appropriate remedial measures. The decision of the Committee and the action taken are communicated to the concerned individual within a stipulated timeframe to ensure transparency and accountability.

The Institution ensures complete confidentiality in handling grievances and guarantees that no student, faculty member, or staff shall face any form of discrimination, harassment, or retaliation for raising a genuine grievance. Periodic review meetings are conducted to monitor the status of grievances, analyze recurring issues, and implement corrective and preventive measures to enhance institutional functioning.

Awareness about the grievance redressal mechanism is created through student induction programmes, staff meetings, the college website, handbooks, and notice boards. This comprehensive Online and Offline Grievance and Redressal Mechanism reflects the unwavering commitment of A.K.T. Memorial College of Engineering and Technology to transparency, accountability, equity, and the overall welfare of all stakeholders.

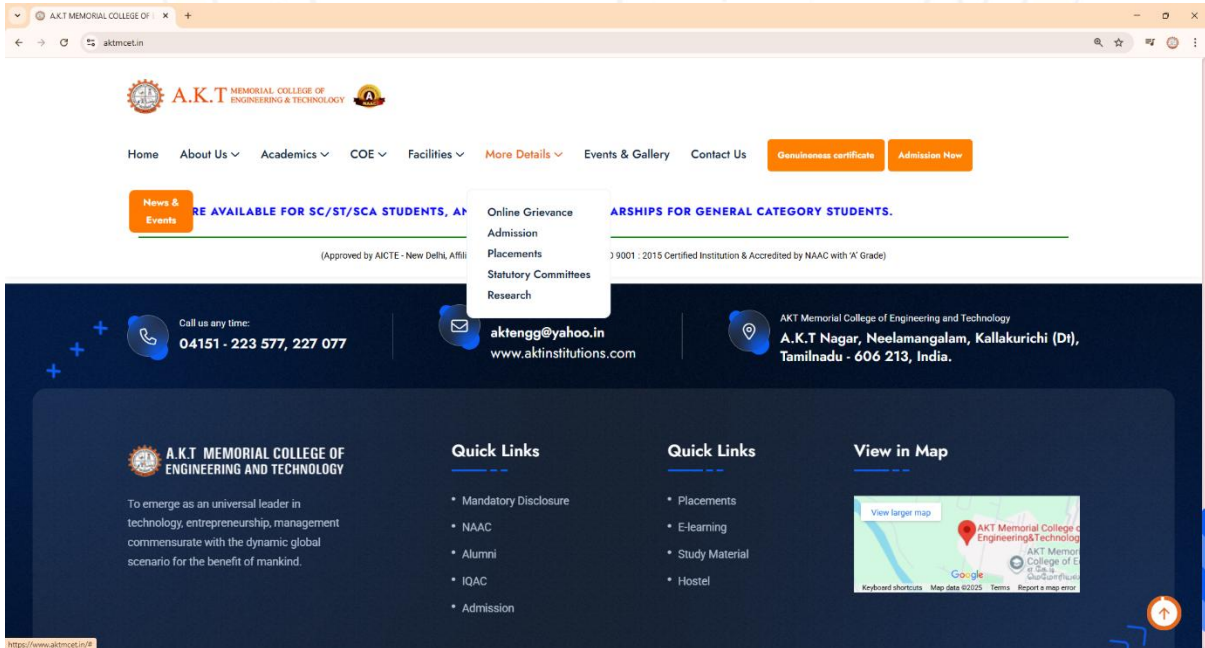

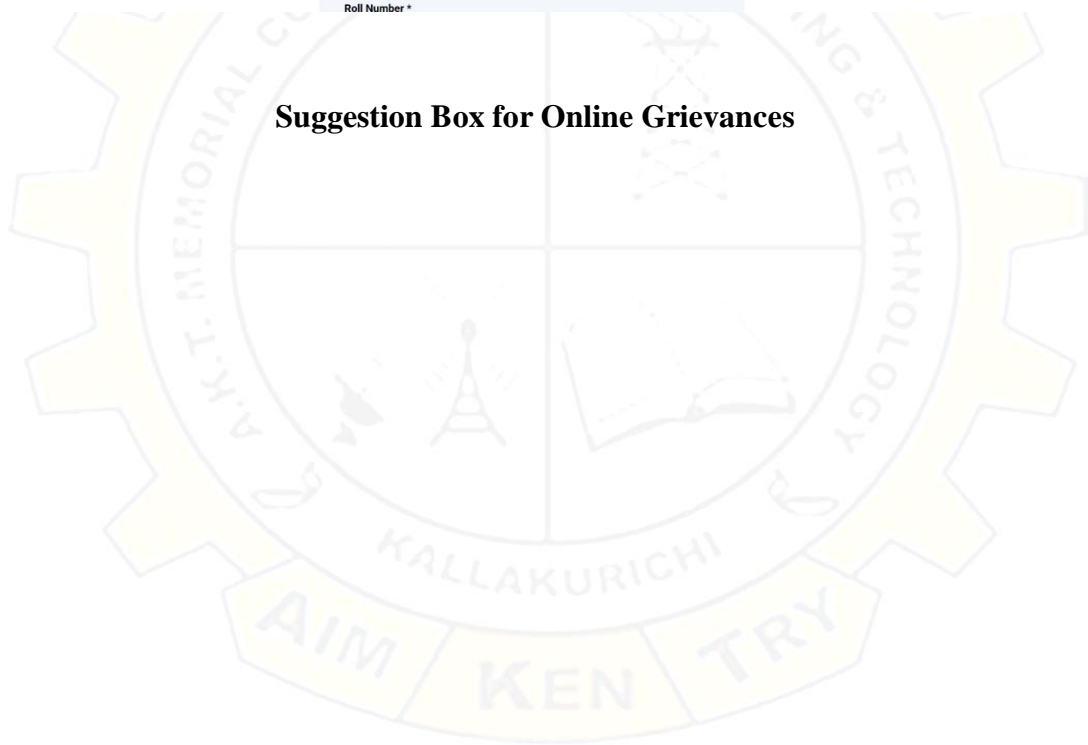



## Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Formulate and review policies and guidelines aimed at preventing and addressing ragging incidents on campus.
2. Ensure that anti-ragging policies are communicated to all students, faculties and staffs.
3. Organize orientation programs for new students to raise awareness about the negative consequences of ragging.
4. Set up confidential mechanisms for reporting ragging incidents, allowing victims and witnesses to report without fear of retaliation.
5. Promptly investigate reported cases of ragging to determine the facts and take appropriate action.
6. Take disciplinary actions against individuals found guilty of engaging in or abetting ragging activities.
7. Provide support and counseling services to victims of ragging to help them cope with the psychological and emotional impact.
8. Establish feedback mechanisms to continuously improve the effectiveness of anti-ragging measures.
9. Work in collaboration with student bodies, clubs, and organizations to promote a culture of mutual respect and discourage ragging.
10. Involve faculty members in anti-ragging initiatives and encourage them to be vigilant in preventing and reporting incidents.
11. Conduct workshops for students to educate them about the consequences of ragging and the importance of maintaining a positive and respectful campus environment.
12. Maintain records of reported ragging incidents, investigations, and actions taken.
13. Implement programs to prevent the occurrence of ragging, including mentorship programs, team-building activities, and community-building initiatives.
14. Collaborate with external organizations, NGOs, and counseling centers to provide additional support and resources for anti-ragging efforts.

### **Roles and Responsibilities:**

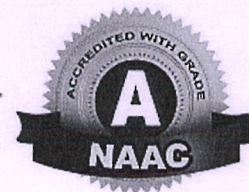
1. The ICC is responsible for organizing awareness programs and training sessions for employees and students to ensure they are informed about the prevention and prohibition of sexual harassment.

6. The ICC should maintain records of all complaints, inquiries, and actions taken, ensuring confidentiality and privacy are respected.
